- Receiving words of encouragement can be powerful!
- For example...Words of encouragement from the DBC family, have been so encouraging, and uplifting
- I thrive off of positive words...words that affirm...that lift up, and don't tear down...
- I can be in the worst of moods, and an encouraging word can turn things around.

• Dennis and Barbara Rainey from their book Building Your Mate's Self- Esteem says this: "Words are like seeds. Once planted in your mate's life, your words will bring forth flowers or weeds, health or disease, healing or poison."

- Proverbs 12:18 "Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing."
- Question: Do we think before we speak? "Be careful with your words. Once they are said, they can be forgiven, not forgotten." Unknown
- Proverbs 15:1 "A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger."
- Question: Are our words gentle?
- Proverbs 18:21 "The tongue has the power of life and death"
- Question: Do our words speak life?

It takes seven positive words to overcome one negative word.

- Will you choose to build up, or tear down? Big choice!
- Each day I choose how I'm going to speak to Jennifer.
- How I speak to her privately, and how I speak about her in public? This can be a game changer in our relationship.

- Here's my challenge for you...What is something encouraging that you can say to your spouse today?
- Remember..."One word can change your spouses' entire day"...SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT!
