

# Faith Talk *Activity* - Feb. 22, 2026

## **Family-Friendly Activity: Integrity Challenge: Same Person Everywhere**

This activity helps families visualize where they might lack integrity and challenges them to become the same person in every context, reflecting the authentic faith Paul calls for in Philippians 2:12.

### *Materials needed:*

- Paper plates (4 per person)
- Markers or crayons
- String or yarn
- Hole punch
- Mirror

### *Instructions:*

1. Create four "masks":
  - Have each family member decorate four paper plates to represent different contexts:
    - Plate 1: "At Home"
    - Plate 2: "At Church"
    - Plate 3: "At School/Work"
    - Plate 4: "Online/Social Media"
2. Draw your "faces":
  - On each plate, draw how you typically act in that setting:
    - What kind of words do you use?
    - How patient are you?
    - How kind are you?
    - How honest are you?

Be honest about the differences between settings

3. Comparison discussion:
  - Hold up the plates side by side
  - Discuss:
    - Which plates look most similar?
    - Which looks most different?
    - Why do we act differently in different places?
    - What would it look like to be the same person everywhere?

4. The "True Face" challenge:

- Look in the mirror together
- Ask: "Who does God see when He looks at me?"
- God sees the real you in every setting
- Discuss: "What would it look like to show my true 'God-facing' self everywhere?"

5. String them together:

- Punch holes in the plates and string them together
- Hang where family can see it
- Reminder that integrity means being the same person regardless of context

6. Celebrate growth:

- When family members demonstrate consistency across settings, celebrate it
- Share stories of choosing integrity when it was difficult
- Discuss how God is working both the desire and the ability to obey in you
