The Security Specialist helps to ensure the church provides the safest possible environment for children and adults attending and serving during weekly services and special events. This position oversees development and implementation of security and safety practices, ensures compliance with local, state and federal rules and regulations, develops volunteers and provides training. Incidents are confronted and addressed in an effective manner that minimizes disruption and harm to persons or property.

Facility Safety

- Regularly assess campus to evaluate needed security and safety services
- Assist in the day-to-day security of campus, specifically our Early Learning Center.
- Approve and issue facility access keycards, keys, and access codes.
- Monitor weather for potential threats and provide timely communication to ministerial staff when disruptions or emergencies occur
- Develop building exit plans for fire, lock down, active shooter, etc. responses
- Promote employee safety at work
- Assist with investigations of accidents or incidents on church property

Security Personnel

- Ensuring functions that involve children and students on campus are supported by security personnel or the Safety Team
- Complete all HR and payroll documents for paid security personnel.
- Co-ordinate First Responder staffing for services and events.

Recruit, Train, Schedule Safety Team

- DBC Utilizes a volunteer Safety Team under the direction of a Safety Team Leader. The Security Specialist will come
 alongside the Team Lead to provide recruitment, training, and scheduling support. members should maintain a
 watchful eye while making rounds, ensuring assigned area is properly patrolled and monitored.
- Ensure the safety team members have clear and adequate communication, knowledge of medical and emergency procedures and best practices, CHL permission and expectations,

On-going training and certifications

- CPR and First Aid
- Active Shooter
- Conflict Resolution and De-escalation
- Maintain current knowledge of church related violence
